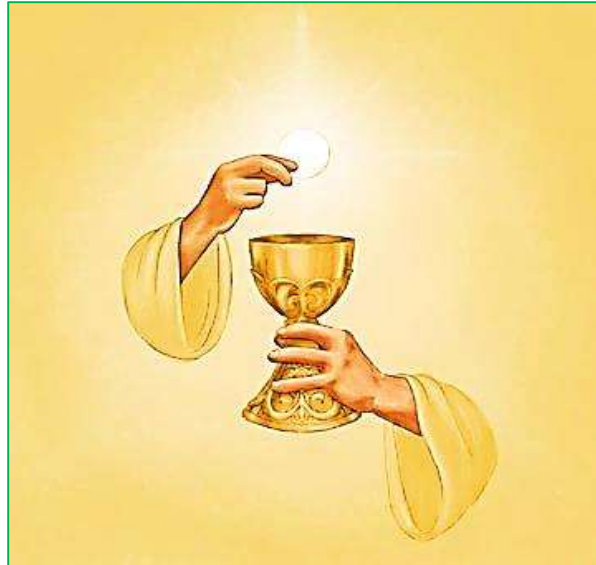

### Safety Concerns

**Though it is legal to panhandle, it is not legal to harass while doing so. We know that as Catholic Christians we should care for the poor and the homeless, but there are safer ways to respond to our Christian call. Pulling out your wallet or purse can be very dangerous. We are concerned for your safety. Our Rector has gift cards to food stores. You can suggest Catholic Charities or other organizations. Unfortunately, many panhandlers only want money and walk away when you do not give it to them, even if you offer them food or water. We ask you kindly not to give money. If you ever feel uncomfortable or unsafe, please dial 911.**
