#### FROM THE DESK OF THE RECTOR:

This weekend at our 10:00 a.m. Mass we welcome all the members of our Judicial System at the Annual Red Mass. We congratulate all the honorees who will be presented the St. Thomas More medal and we recognize all the past honorees. We thank you for your service to our local communities and our country protecting and enforcing the laws of our Commonwealth and nation.

The tradition of the Red Mass was begun by Pope Innocent IV in 1243 for the Ecclesial Judicial Court asking the invocation of the Holy Spirit as a source of wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude and strength for the coming term of the court. The color red signifies the Holy Spirit and martyrdom. It is also the color worn by the members of the Roman Rota - the ecclesiastical Tribunal of the Vatican. The Red Mass is celebrated annually, traditionally on the Sunday before the first Monday in October, which marks the opening of the Supreme Court's annual term.

We invoke God's blessings on those responsible for the administration of justice as well as on all public officials.

We will be having Mass in the St. Augustine Crypt Chapel on the anniversary of our diocesan bishops buried in our crypt. Thomas Mary O'Leary who died on Oct. 10, 1949.

#### October is Respect Life Month and Month on the Holy Rosary

#### **RESPECT LIFE MONTH:**

This Sunday, the first Sunday of October, is Respect Life Sunday, the day on which the American Catholics, Protestants, Jews, Muslims, and even truth-seeking agnostics and atheists are called to reflect on the gift of human life and shore up our efforts to cherish it and defend it wherever it is threatened. With the events in recent years of school shootings, terrorism attacks, violence in our streets and senseless shootings we have become more sensitized as a nation to respect innocent human life, because we all have seen the consequences of what can happen when those without a respect for human life have the ability to achieve their ends. And we should all be resolved to stop them, because not only is it a threat to us and our families, but it is a huge offense to God.

We need to re-examine our own culture. People ask why terrorists hate America so much that they would commit suicide to try to teach her a lesson? Because they think that America has a culture that has no disregard for innocent human life. Because they think America follows the inspiration of the Devil and not God. Because they think America doesn't have true freedom - which is the ability to do what one ought before God and others — but rather choose to do whatever one pleases, whether right or wrong.

This is what they cite: In the US alone (2021), upwards of 3,000 children, made in the image and likeness of God, are slaughtered in their mothers' wombs every single day. They say, America doesn't deplore this terrible violence against human life, but in fact celebrates it as a "constitutional right." They ask themselves, would this be a people that is following God, or following Satan, a culture that affirms human life or a culture of death?

This is worth our reflection - to stand by for the unborn who have no voices, for the senseless killings in our streets and so much more. We need to cry out as righteous men and women and say that this evil must stop and we need to regain our country's soul again. We pray for all our Holy Innocents murdered each day as well as those who lose their lives to gun violence. May God bless our nation!
