ALL SOULS DAY ENVELOPES:

The month of November is dedicated to prayer for the Holy Souls in Purgatory. The most effective way of getting souls released from purgatory in order to enjoy the beauty of heaven is through the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. It is for this reason that we offer Mass intentions for our deceased loved ones. The month of November is a very beneficial month for the souls in purgatory because of the Masses and prayers offered for them. In preparation for this month of Masses for the Dead, we prepare by listing the names of our loved ones on the envelope provided you and place a monetary gift in the envelope as an offering to God for the celebration of Masses for them during the month. The envelopes will be placed on the Cathedral Altar for the entire month beginning on November 2nd, All Souls Day. Envelopes are available at the entrances to the Cathedral. Please make your offering for the Holy Souls, include the names on the envelope, and place it in the collection basket next weekend (October 26/27) or on Friday, November 1st, All Saints Day (a Holy day of Obligation) or on Masses that will be celebrated on Saturday, November 2nd, All Souls Day. Because the priest has the privilege of offering 3 Masses for the Holy Souls that day, we will have a few Masses at the cathedral. See announcement below. Next weekend in the bulletin will be an explanation of our Catholic teaching on purgatory.
