May God bless us as we enter into Jesus' Passion, Death and Resurrection.

24 HOURS OF MERCY: SIGN UP FOR ADORATION


As part of our 24 Hours of Mercy, we will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the Cathedral church. We will expose Our Lord in the monstrance after the 12:10 p.m. Mass on Friday, April 25th and will remain there until 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 26th.

This is the <u>The Divine Mercy Sunday</u> weekend and it is the 25th Anniversary of its declaration by Pope St. John Paul II as The Divine Mercy Sunday, declared on April 30, 2000.

There is a sign up board near the side entrance (parking lot side). Please consider giving Jesus at least one hour of adoration and also take part in the Sacrament of Confession. NO EXCUSES that you don't have time - because surely you could find some time in a 24-hour period to adore Our Lord and confess your sins.



TONY MELENDEZ COMING TO ST. MICHAEL'S CATHEDRAL CONCERTS/ADORATION:



Originally from Nicaragua, Tony was born without arms and a clubbed foot. At the age of one Tony's family immigrated to the USA so Tony could have corrective surgery on his left foot in order for him to walk. Tony grew up in a home where mom protected and cared greatly for him and at the same time had a father who encouraged and pushed him to do things on his own. As he had no arms Tony had to learn to do almost everything with his feet and at the age of 16 taught himself how to play the guitar with his toes. In 1987 he was asked by the youth of Los Angeles to be their gift to Pope John Paul II. It was this internationally broadcast event that set Tony's career in to high gear, now more than 31 years later Tony has traveled to all 50 states and more than 44 foreign countries. Tony has recorded 6 albums and published his autobiography, A Gift Of Hope.

Tony will be at the Cathedral for 2 concerts – Tuesday May 6th at 7pm in English and Wednesday, May 7th in Spanish. Both evenings will include a Holy Hour. The concert is open to all free of charge. A free will offering will be taken during the concert to defray expenses for this concert.
