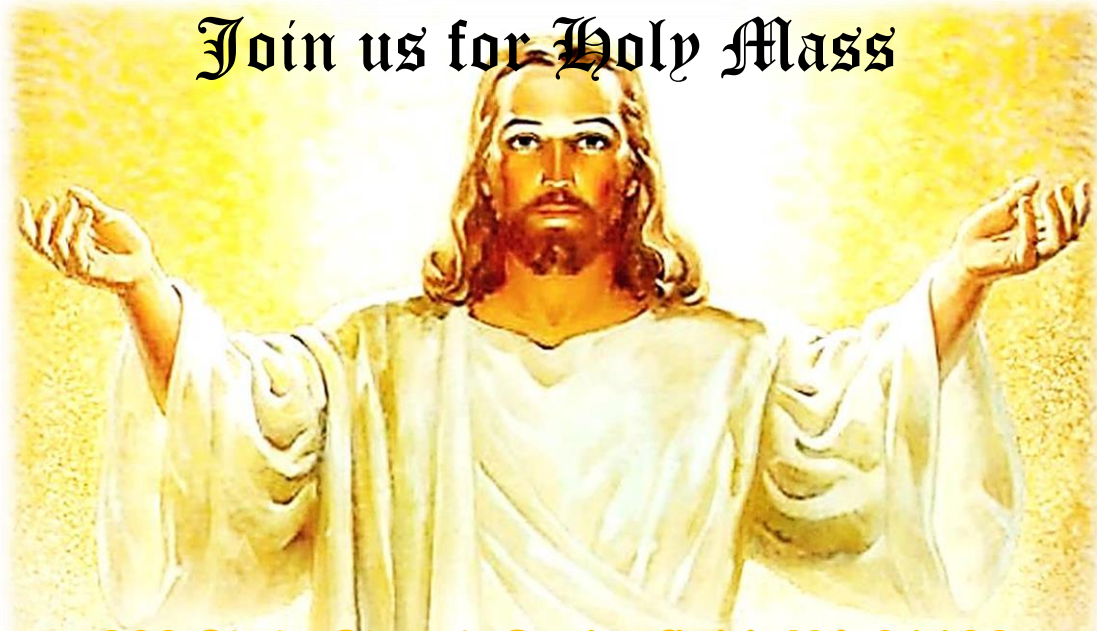

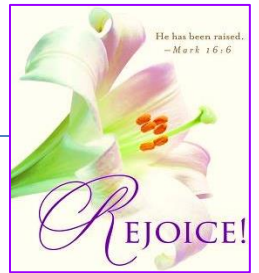

We have concluded our Lenten journey and the Sacred Triduum and now we celebrate Easter Resurrection. This is indeed the day the Lord has made, so let us rejoice and be glad in it. Now we begin 50 days of Eastertide. But first, we enter into the Octave of Easter. These 8 days of Easter Octave we celebrate it as if it were Easter day. The reason is that we cannot begin to understand, contemplate or comprehend what has happened for us in just one day (Easter). The Church gives us 8 days to celebrate and understand the immense glory of Jesus Risen and what he has gained for us by his Passion, Death and Resurrection. All the readings of these 8 days will focus on various aspects of the Resurrection. Thank you Jesus for all you have done for us and especially for opening the gates of heaven for all the righteous who seek to do Your will.

In conjunction with the confessions that will be heard for 24 hours from 1pm Friday, April 25 to 1pm Saturday, April 26 we will be having Eucharistic Adoration. Please sign up to spend an Holy Hour with our Eucharistic Lord. **PLEASE NOTE:** There is no fear of coming to the Cathedral in the night hours - we will have a police presence and young men will be guarding the cathedral church and hallways to the bathrooms and Marshall Center.

THE GRACES OF THE DIVINE MERCY:

Next weekend we celebrate the 25th Anniversary of Pope St. John Paul II announcing the Second Sunday of Easter as The Divine Mercy Sunday. This great feast comes with it abundant graces to those who confess their sins. In the Diary of St. Faustina, Our Lord Jesus promises to grant complete forgiveness of sins and punishment on the Feast of Mercy. Jesus said: **"I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My mercy" (1109). "Whoever approaches the Fountain of Life on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment" (300). "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion will obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment" (699).**

For this reason it is so important to confess your sins this coming weekend and so afford that opportunity to yourself by coming to the Cathedral for the 24 Hours of Mercy. No excuses to find a time to come in a 24 hour period.
