Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord

From the Rector's Desk:

On the evening of Easter when Jesus appeared to the apostles in the Upper Room he established the Sacrament of Confession when he breathed on them and gave them the authority to forgive and retain sins. In the Diary of St. Faustina: Divine Mercy in My Soul (a highly recommended read for all) Jesus speaks directly to St. Faustina about his infinite mercy. He asked that a feast of His Mercy be established on the Second Sunday of Easter through which he extends tremendous graces and mercy on the soul that repents of his/her sins. "The Decree from the Sacred Penitentiary of the Vatican states: ...Divine Mercy knows how to pardon even the most serious sins, and in doing so it moves the faithful to perceive a supernatural, not merely psychological, sorrow for their sins so that, ever with the help of divine grace, they may make a firm resolution not to sin any more. Such spiritual dispositions undeniably follow upon the forgiveness of mortal sin when the faithful fruitfully receive the sacrament of Penance... To ensure that the faithful observe this day with intense devotion, the Supreme Pontiff himself established that the Second Sunday of Easter be enriched by a plenary indulgence, so the faithful might receive in great abundance the gift of the consolation of the Holy Spirit. And so the Supreme Pontiff, motivated by an ardent desire to foster in Christians this devotion to Divine Mercy as much as possible in the hope of offering great spiritual fruit to the faithful.... grants the following Indulgence: A *plenary indulgence*, granted under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of the Pope) to the faithful who, on the Second Sunday of Easter or Divine Mercy Sunday, in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our *Father* and the *Creed*, adding devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. Jesus, I trust in you!") In addition..... the sick and those who nurse them, and all who for a just cause cannot leave their homes... may obtain a plenary indulgence on Divine Mercy Sunday, if totally detesting any sin, as has been said before, and with the intention of fulfilling as soon as possible the three usual conditions, will recite the Our *Father* and the *Creed* before a devout image of Our Merciful Jesus and pray a devout invocation to the Merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. Merciful Jesus, I trust in you).

To our sacristans, Jacob and Michael for their assistance in making sure all things were properly placed. MEMORIAL DONATIONS:

We received an anonymous donation of \$1,000 for the St. Michael Statue in the cathedral. The donor requested it be in memory and honor of St. Padre Pio. We also received two donations in the amount of \$500 for 2 new vestments for our Cathedral Church. Memorial tags have been placed inside the vestment. We have purchased a new green vestment for the cathedral that can be memorialized for a gift of \$800. We have a couple other vestments that can be memorialized for \$500 each.
